





# Access VPN via SecureAuth OTP

- ① When launching the CISCO VPN your icon will display as follows:




- ② Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client will appear.

  - Select Connect




# Access VPN via SecureAuth OTP

- ② You will then be prompted to enter the SecureAuth password.




# Access VPN via SecureAuth OTP

(sent via text message, email, or phone call) – used for initial set up of your account on your device.

**Create Your Personal PIN Number**  
PIN that you create to access the SecureAuth app on your device – you will have to enter this number into your device every time you want a SecureAuth code.

Enter this number on the computer you are logging into.








# Accessing PowerChart (cont.)

- After selecting the appropriate domain, click on the “Millennium Apps” folder:




- Once in “Millennium Apps”, select “PowerChart” (you can also type “powerchart” in the search field and it will bring you directly to the icon).

# Accessing PowerChart (cont.)

- Once in PowerChart, you should see your Patient List (\*note the Patient List includes both active encounters and <30 days post discharge).
