## Letter From the CEO

Dear Friends,

As the new year begins, it is appropriate to take a moment to look back at 2019 and reflect on our global mission work. During 2019, we expanded our global mission footprints to include the Dominican Republic and Honduras. We have officially begun to work with Garden View Medical Center (Centro Medico Vista del Jardin) in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic and Valley of Angels Adventist Hospital (Hospital Adventista Valle de Angeles) in Valle de Angeles, Honduras. Both hospitals share our mission to extend the healing ministry of Christ to the communities they serve.

In 2019, our physicians, nurses and other staff continued to volunteer their time, talent and treasure to serve those in need around the world. Our volunteers treated women with cervical cancer in Mexico, screened for colon cancer in Peru, brought relief to those affected by Hurricane Dorian in the Bahamas, and delivered primary care to people in Ethiopia, Honduras, the Philippines and more. Through philanthropy raised by our AdventHealth Foundation, we were able to donate and install x-ray systems for Haiti and Honduras, deliver food and medical equipment to the Bahamas, and ship a cardiac cath lab to the Philippines. Our 6th Global Conference for Nursing Excellence was held on our Altamonte campus with participants from the Caribbean and Asia.

As you read this report, we hope you will see a glimpse of the whole-person care we are committed to bringing to people around the world.

### ■ Philippines

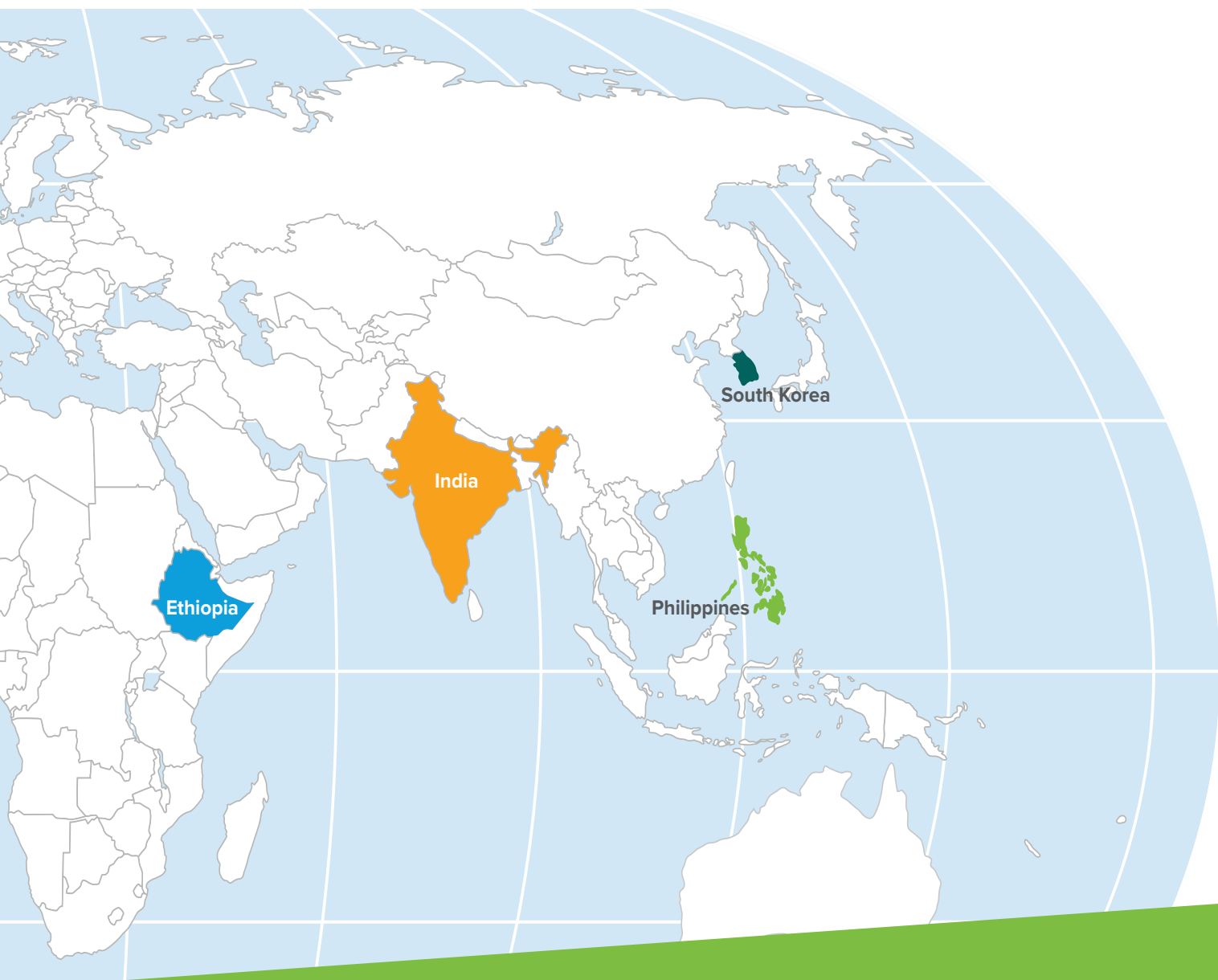

## Mexico Mission Trip

For several years, AdventHealth Global Missions has supported the AdventHealth Family Medicine Residency and Women's Health Fellowship in their work to improve health outcomes for women in rural areas. Since 2005, the medical team has provided care to over 2,000 indigenous Mexican women, with the goal of making a lasting impact on screening and treatment for cervical cancer. The medical care includes colposcopies and colposcopic exams, cryosurgery, LEEPs, treatment of all gynecological infections, and provision of antibiotics and vitamins.

## Philippines Mission Trip

The Kalala Learning Village welcomed our missionary team at the Summit Clinic, a health care establishment located within Kalala that serves the people in the community and the school.

Our volunteer group of physicians, nurses and other health care professionals on this trip had the opportunity to care for school children as well as people living in the surrounding communities. Our care team included an optometrist who fitted people with prescription eyeglasses and made it possible for them to see clearly again.

# Construction Projects & Container Report

AdventHealth Global Missions works together with the Footprint hospitals to deliver quality health care services to the communities they serve and aid in fulfilling their missions as faith-based organizations. The mutual goals of improving the quality of care, enhancing processes, developing the physical infrastructure and ensuring the sustainability of the Footprint hospitals are made a reality through construction projects and delivery of equipment and materials through container loads.

In 2019 we were proud to work together and highlight these four Footprint locations and their projects as they came to fruition.

## 1. Ethiopia: Construction of High School classrooms and expansion of dental clinic

The Kalala Learning Village (KLV) provides quality education in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, to hundreds of children. In 2019, KLV expanded their high school classrooms to accommodate growth and fulfill their commitment in providing K-12 education.

The Dental Clinic received a much-needed expansion of their front entrance. Located on the KLV campus, this micro-industry lacked an entrance to the public. They are now open to the community, serving more patients and growing their services.

## 2. Haiti – Development of Imaging Services and Laboratory

In 2019, Haiti Adventist Hospital (HAH) received the donation of a floor-mounted X-ray machine, and an Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) system was added to the CT machine that was donated in 2018. These two additions provide reliable imaging services for their patients and better patient care.

HAH's medical laboratory services were expanded with a renovation of the department, new equipment and tools.







### 3. Honduras: X-ray system with digital imaging and Ultrasound machine

Hospital Adventista Valle de Angeles received a floor mounted X-ray with digital imaging. In addition, a donation of an ultrasound machine allows them to expand their Imaging service line, have better diagnostic services, provide better care for their patients and increase the overall revenue for the hospital.

### 4. Philippines: Cath Lab to Adventist Medical Center – Bacolod

A project that had taken a year to develop with architectural drawings, clinical care training and supply chain processing became a reality on October 24, 2019 when a Cath Lab was placed on a container and shipped to Bacolod, located on the fourth largest island of the Philippines. The collaboration between Global Missions, AdventHealth Orlando and the AdventHealth Cardiovascular Institute allowed this donation to become a reality and provide access to better diagnostic and treatment services the people of Bacolod.





# Operation Sunshine – Haiti



The Operation Sunshine program's mission and purpose is to provide health care to children living in orphanages in the area of Port-au-Prince, Haiti. Working alongside My Neighbor's Children — a Florida-based non-profit group — orphanages and group homes have been identified to participate in this program, with 500+ children enrolled to date. In years past, volunteer groups comprised of pediatric physicians and nurses under the clinical leadership of Drs. McConkey and Loe have visited Haiti at least twice a year to conduct

annual medical checkups on the children. In 2019, all volunteer trips to Haiti were postponed to a future date due to the political unrest in the country, and as such we relied on Haiti Adventist Hospital to provide health care, including physician consultations, medications, laboratory tests and hospitalization.

AdventHealth Global Missions remains committed to the Operation Sunshine program and ever-hopeful that volunteer groups will return to Haiti to continue the work with the children. Fundraising for the Operation Sunshine program ensures that children that are most vulnerable receive the health care they need, exactly when they need it.





## Bahamas Relief Efforts

On September 1, 2019, Hurricane Dorian struck Abaco Islands as a category 5 storm and a day later moved to Grand Bahama Island. The impact was devastating and perceived as amongst the worst natural disaster the Bahamian islands had ever experienced. Many people perished, and thousands were left homeless and in need of medical care. On September 6, 2019, AdventHealth President Terry Shaw communicated with all employees and urged them to help the medical relief efforts that were being organized by the Global Missions department and give support either financially and/or by becoming a volunteer. AdventHealth employees responded and raised over \$150,000 for Bahamas relief efforts.

AdventHealth Global Missions along with the clinical leadership of Dr. Alric Simmonds and Dr. Reagan Schwartz worked with Bahamas Public Hospitals Authority to determine the best course of action after the storm. Medical teams comprised of Emergency Room physicians and physician assistants supported Bahamian health professionals that were impacted by the storm themselves. Medical supplies such as incubators and an ambulance were shipped to fulfill immediate needs Bahamian hospitals faced. A food-packing event was held where more than



100,000 meals were readied and shipped to be prepared and served in the Bahamas. In November 2019, a group of six representatives from Princess Margaret Hospital in Nassau, Bahamas visited AdventHealth Orlando and Celebration to plan and collaborate on future biomedical support projects at Princess Margaret Hospital, and organize clinical support to the Rand Memorial Hospital Accident and Emergency Department.

AdventHealth Global Missions is committed to the continued support in providing relief efforts to the Bahamas.





# 6th Global Conference for Nursing Excellence

AdventHealth and AdventHealth University welcomed 31 nurses from six different countries for our Annual Nursing Conference. The conference covered an array of topics focusing on ICardiovascular Patient Care. It was an opportunity for our nurses to connect with peers from different countries, expand their knowledge, and focus on the pursuit of nursing excellence.

Some highlights of the conference included the AdventHealth Nursing Education Department leading our nurses through a Clinical Immersion Simulation in three different cardiac scenarios at the AdventHealth Medical Simulation Training Annex. The simulation training was supplemented by various sessions around cardiovascular patient care. The conference also featured a training in the Stress Recovery Effect training, teaching the participants how to employ CREATION Life principles into their work.





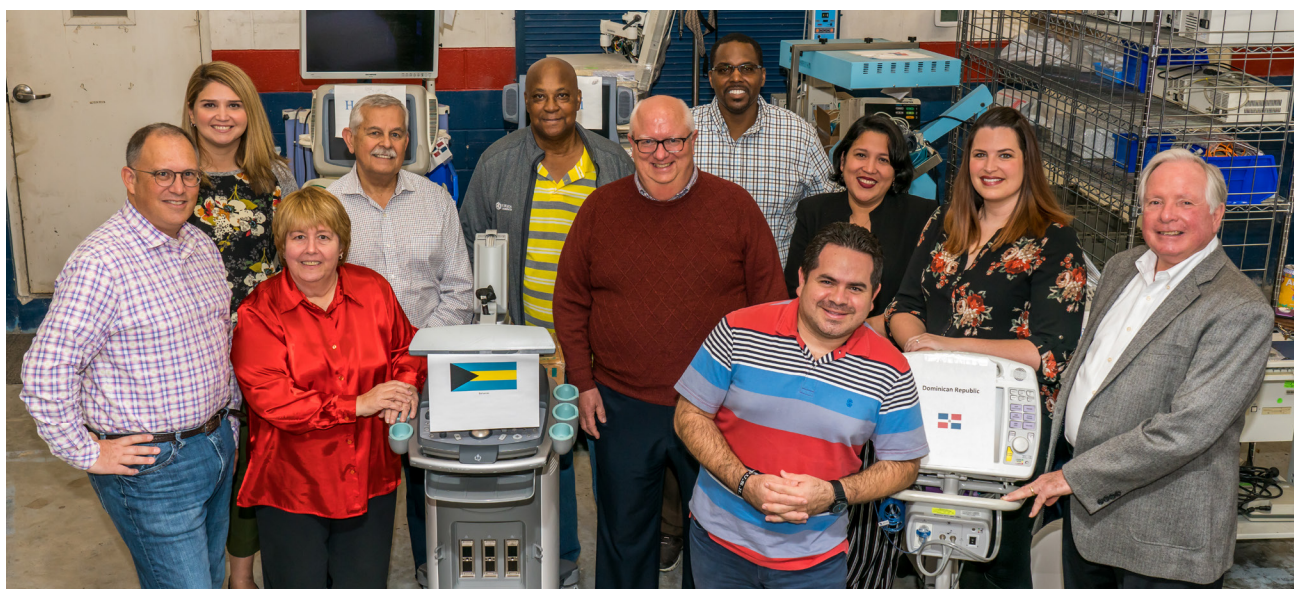
# Philanthropy Report
